Unconstitutional Amendments & the Midterm Election

AMENDMENTS ON THE BALLOT

Property Tax Amendment

Sounds like tax relief. It **actually strips** your county commissioners of local control and hands that power to the legislature. The legislature already has the authority to cut property taxes and is choosing not to use it.

Income Tax Limit Amendment

Sounds like fiscal responsibility. It **actually forces** the state to rely on fees and sales taxes that hit working families hardest. Designed to constrain future revenue options for progressive leadership.

Voter ID

Sounds administrative. It is **actually an unnecessary anti-voter measure** that creates concern around access to the ballot box.

AMENDMENTS BEING CONSIDERED

Right to Work Amendment

Sounds like workplace freedom. It **actually strips** workers of the right to unionize and constitutionally eliminates collective bargaining protections.

Right to Farm Amendment

Sounds like protecting farmers. It **actually transfers** farming regulation from local counties to the legislature, benefiting corporate agriculture at the expense of small and Black-owned farms.

Council of State Appointment Amendment

Sounds like government reform. It **actually restricts** the governor's appointment power in ways designed to entrench partisan control.

Elect SBE Superintendent as Chair Amendment

Sounds like giving voters more say. It **actually removes** the Governor's authority to appoint State Board of Education members, shifting control to voters and making the Superintendent of Public Instruction the automatic Chair.

Permitless Carry Amendment

Sounds like protecting your rights. It **actually eliminates** the permit requirement for concealed carry, allowing anyone legally able to own a firearm to carry it concealed with no background check, training, or permit.
